2. RESERVATION FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED PERSONS :

2.1 As per G.R. Medical Education and Drug Dept. No. MES-1202/(81)/MES-1, dated 19th August, 2005 amongst Physically Challenged candidates only Partially Deaf and Locomotor Disability (One leg affected / One arm affected) candidates are eligible for this post and candidates only who submits the certificate mentioning clearly such type of disability will only be considered for the post.

2.2 The reservation for physically challenged persons is as per Govt. Circular, Social Justice & Special Assistance Department No.Apang-2007/C.R.61/sudhar-3, Dated 20th April, 2007.

3. PAY :

Rs.16400-450-20900-500-22400 plus Rs.1000/- Special Pay (T.E. approximately Rs. 46,000)and other admissible allowances as per prevalent rules.

4. AGE :

4.1 Not more than **45** years as on **1st June, 2009**. Relaxable as per rules.

4.2 The upper age limit shall not apply to employee of Govt. of Maharashtra.

4.3 Age limit may be relaxed by the Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates with exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

5. QUALIFICATIONS : 5.1 Candidate must possess ----

5.1.1 A degree in MBBS and post-graduate degree in any branch of Medical Science or a qualification recognised as equivalent to a post-graduate degree by the Medical Council of India, Constituted under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956) **AND THEREAFTER**

5.1.2 Ten years experience of teaching in a post not below the rank than that of Associate Professor or Reader in a Medical College out of which atleast Five years experience should be in the post of Professor in a Medical College or Medical Research Institute.

5.2 Preference will be given to candidates having experience of research in medical subjects evidenced by publications in a Medical Journal (work accepted for publication will be regarded as evidence.)

6. DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES : The details regarding duties and responsibilities of the post is available on web site of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission.

7. GENERAL :

7.1 Selected candidates will be on probation for a period of two years.

7.2 There are prospects of promotion to the post of Joint Director / Director.

7.3 All things being equal preference will be given to Backward Class candidates.

7.4 Selected candidates will have to sign the agreement embodying the condition of their service including the condition to serve Govt. for a period of five years or to pay a penalty of Rs.10,000/-(Rs.Ten Thousand) or such other sum as may be prescribed by Govt.

7.5 The selected candidates will have to get themselves registered maintained under the Maharashtra Medical Council Act, 1965 (Mah. XLVI of 1965) before joining or their name should be borne on Indian Medical Register maintained under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956).

7.6 Selected candidates will be debarred from doing any private practice but will be paid compensatory allowance in lieu according to the rules.

7.7 The Commission at it's discretion, may shortlist the applicants for interview based on reasonable criteria, i.e. experience and/or higher qualification, etc. OR may conduct written objective type screening test (multiple choice question) to shortlist the candidates for interview. The syllabus and medium of question paper and other details for the test shall be displayed on the Commission's Website.

7.8 Copies of certificates should not be attached along with application form. However, candidates are required to furnish a affidavit on a stamp paper of Rs.100/- to be affirmed before Notary in respect of correctness and authenticity of the information mentioned in the application form. Specimen of affidavit is published on the web site alongwith the duties and responsibilities of said post.

7.9 The Application Form should be accompanied by an affidavit, failing which it will be treated as incomplete & will be rejected.

7.10 The candidate should submit all the original certificates alongwith one set of xerox copies of the certificates at the time of interview as per instruction given in chapter-4 of the prospectus provided alongwith the application form.
