2. RESERVATION FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED PERSONS :-

2.1 As per G.R., Medical Education and Drug Dept. No.MES-1202 /(81) / MES - 1, dt. 19 th August, 2005, Physically Challenged Candidates are not eligible for the subjects Gastroenterology.

2.2 Eligibility / Non-eligibility in the sub-categories of Physically Challenged Candidates for the remaining subjects as per advertisement is mentioned below and only those candidates shall be considered for the said post, who submit disability certificate containing specifically the categories of disability.

2.3 The reservation for Physically Challenged persons shall be as per Government Circular, Social Justice and Special Assistance Department, No. Apang-2007/C.R.61/ Sudhar-3, dt. 20th April, 2007.

3. PAY:- Rs.12,000 - 420 - 18,300 plus other admissible allowances as per prevalent Rules.(T.E. Approx. Rs. 33000/-)

4. AGE :-

- 4.1 Not more than 35 years as on 1st July, 2009. Relaxable as per Rules..
 4.2 The upper age limit shall not apply to Maharashtra State Government Servants.
 4.3 Age limit may be relaxed by the Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates possessing exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

- 5.2 Preference may be given to candidates having experience of research work in the relevant subject and those who have published articles of research work in the relevant subject in a recognised medical journal. Minimum of Four Research Publications indexed in Index Medicus / national journals is desirable.
- 5.3 All medical teachers must possess a basic University or equivalent qualification included in any one of the Schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956).
- 5.4 Medical Teachers must possess the requisite recognised post -graduate medical qualification in their respective subjects.
- 5.5 The post-graduate qualifications mentioned in the Schedule shall stand amended in accordance with the recognition or de-recognition of such post-graduate qualification by the Medical Council of India from time to time.
- 5.6 In exceptional case, where candidates with experience prescribed in the para 5.1 above are not available, the Govt. may, on the recommendation of the Commission, make appointment to a post of Associate Professor on consideration of merits of the candidates & make a simultaneous reference to the Medical Council of India for relaxation of the prescribed experience.
- 5.7 Where a candidate has worked in a recognised research institution or a medical college and has produced original research work of a very high quality recognised as original scientific contribution at a national or international level or at both, it will be considered by Govt. as equivalent to teaching experience provided other conditions are fulfilled.
- 5.8 Appointment of candidates possessing the non medical Doctorate as mentioned in the advertisement the posts of Associate Professor in Physiology, Pharmacology, Anatomy, & Microbiology shall be made, if candidates with requisite medical qualifications in these subjects are not available. The total number of posts of Associate Professors in such subjects held by such persons with non medical qualifications shall not exceed 30 per cent in case of the total number of existing posts of Associate Professors in case of Physiology, Pharmacology, Anatomy & Microbiology

7. GENERAL :

- 7.1 Selected candidates will be on probation for a period of two years. There are prospects of promotion to the post of Professor & Dean.
- 7.2 Selected candidates will have to get himself or herself registered under the Maharashtra Medical Council Act, 1965 (Mah.XLVI of 1965) or on the register maintained under the Central Act, before joining, unless he has already been so registered or his name is borne on the Indian Medical Register.
- 7.3 Selected Candidates will be required to sign the agreement embodying the condition of their service including the condition to serve Govt. for the period of 5 years or to pay a bond penalty of Rs.10,000/- (Rs.Ten Thousand) or such other sum as may be prescribed by Government from time to time.
- 7.4 Selected Candidates will be debarred from doing any private practice but will be paid compensatory allowances in lieu according to the rules.
- 7.5 The Commission at it's discretion, may shortlist the applicants for interview based on reasonable criteria, i.e. experience and/or higher qualification, etc. OR may conduct written objective type screening test (multiple choice question) to shortlist the candidates for interview. The syllabus and medium of question paper and other details for the test shall be displayed on the Commission's Website.
- 7.6 Copies of certificates should not be attached with application form. However, candidates are required to furnish a **affidavit on a stamp paper of Rs.100/- to be affirmed before Notary** in respect of correctness and authenticity of the information mentioned in the application form. Specimen of affidavit is published on the web site in the "Specimen form of Affidavit for Direct Recruitment Posts" section.
- 7.7 The Application Form should be accompanied by an affidavit, failing which it will be treated as incomplete & will be rejected.
- 7.8 The candidate should submit all the original certificates alongwith one set of xerox copies of the certificates **at the time of interview** as per instruction given in chapter-4 of the prospectus provided alongwith the application form.
