1	<u>INTRODUCTION</u>
1.1	The Government of Maharashtra has decided to recruit competent and efficient staff nurses on the basis of merit through competitive written examination.
1.2	<u>Objectives</u>
1.2.1	This competitive written examination is meant for recruitment of competent candidates for the post of staff nurses and to appoint selected G.N.M/B. Sc. (Nursing) & M. Sc. (Nursing) trained nurses in the hospital under establishment of Director of Medical education & Research, Mumbai. (Government of Maharashtra)
2	<u>DEFENITIONS :</u>
2.1	"Competent Authority" - Means authority appointed by the Maharashtra Government for the purpose of conduct of competitive written examination for the post of Staff Nurses
2.2	" Divisional Authority" The Dean of specified Govt. Medical Colleges & Hospitals will be known as Divisional Authority and will be responsible to carry out the directions and instructions of the Competent Authority.
2.3	"Notified Examination Centers" - The Matron office of the Medical Colleges and Hospitals responsible for distribution of information brochures, for competitive written examination - 2010, receipt of the applications forms, collection and distribution of Admit Cards and Mark Sheets of Competitive Written Examination.
2.4	"Appeal Committee" - A committee under the chairmanship of the Competent Authority shall deal with representations submitted by the candidates regarding competitive written examination and the selection process for the recruitment of the post of Staff Nurses. The role of Matron shall be the vital role as a Nursing expert.
2.5	"G.N.M./R.G.N.M." - A 3 or 3 ^{1/2} Years diploma nursing and training course recognised by the INC, New Delhi & recognised by the MNC (M.S.) & approved by the Government of Maharashtra.
2.6	"Basic B.Sc. (Nursing)" - A 4 Years undergraduate degree course in nursing and Post Basic B.Sc. 2 Years degree Course recognised by the INC, New Delhi & recognised by the MNC (M.S.) & approved by the Govt. of Maharashtra.
2.7	"Maharashtra Nursing Council" (MNC) - is a autonomous body functioning under the jurisdiction of Maharashtra State for the recognition of diploma nursing course, conduction of said course examination, providing registration to the candidates who have successfully completed the nursing courses.
2.8	"Indian Nursing Council" (INC) - means the Indian Nursing Council established under the Indian Nursing Council Act, 1947.

2.9	"University" - means the non agricultural universities constituted under the Maharashtra University Act, 1994 and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik constituted under MUHS Act, 1998.
2.10	"Competitive Written Examination" - A written examination introduce for selection of meritorious of Staff Nurse.
2.11	"Scheduled Cast (SC)" means Scheduled Caste as specified and laid down by the Government of Maharashtra.
2.12	"Scheduled Tribes (ST)"- means Scheduled Tribes as specified laid down by the Government of Maharashtra. Scheduled Tribes candidates should produce Caste Validity Certificate at the time of scrutiny of Original Certificates.
2.13	"Vimukta Jati (VJ)"- means Vimukta Jati as per specified and laid down by Government of Maharashtra.
2.14	"Nomadic Tribes (NT) - means as specified and laid down by Government of Maharashtra.
2.15	"Other Backward Classes/Special Backward Class (OBC/SBC)" - means other Backward Class/Special backward class as specified and laid down by Government of Maharashtra.
2.16	"Physically Handicapped (PH)" means Physically Handicapped candidates as per the Government Resolution issue by Govt. of Maharashtra vide G.R. MES-1202/(81)/MED-1, Dated 19 August, 2005 subject to the physical fitness awaited in CET Brochure.
2.17	"Project Affected Persons (PAP)" - means Project Affected Persons as per the Govt. Resolution issued by Govt. of Maharashtra.
2.18	" Bond Free" - As per Gr.20/05/2005 all the Candidates are Bond Free.
3	CONDUCT OF COMPETITIVE WRITTEN EXAMINATION
3.1	The Candidates decided eligible for the written test. will have to appear for the exam. on their own cost.
3.2	The competitive written examination 2010 will be conducted on Sunday 26/09/2010 on 10.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.
3.3	The competitive written examination will be conducted at various centres stated in Annexure "A".
3.4	The competitive examination will be conducted in English only.
3.5	MHN-CWT paper will be of two and half hours duration containing 150 multiple choice questions (MCQS). Questions will be of single best response objective type with four answer options. Each correct response shall be awarded one mark. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers, scratching, overwriting, tick mark and multiple answers will be considered as wrong answers and no marks will be awarded to them.
3.6	Competitive Written Examination shall be of the standard of General Nursing & Midwifery Examination and shall cover all the subjects of General Nursing & Midwifery Courses.

4	SCHEME OF EXAMINATION
4.1	Date of Examination :- The examination will be conduct at various centers in Maharashtra on Sunday (Dated 26/09/2010)
4.2	Schedule and test design :- The competitive written examination MHN-CWT-2010 will consist of one question paper carrying 150 questions and total 150 marks the paper shall be objective type.
4.3	Syllabus of Examination :- 125 questions shall be based on syllabus of G.N.M./ Basic B.Sc. Syllabus and 25 questions shall be general aptitude test.
4.4	Time and duration of examination :- There will be one paper. The medium for examination shall be English only. The duration of examinations is two and half hours.
5	ELEGIBILITY
5.1	The applicant must be an Indian National and Domicile of Maharashtra State.
5.2	<u>Education Qualification :</u> General Nursing Midwifery 3 or 3 ^{1/2} years Diploma Course OR B.Sc. Nursing (Basic/Post Basic) Degree Course. The applicant must have passed General Nursing and Midwifery / Psychiatric Nursing /Orthopedic Nursing or Operation Theatre technique from any nursing school/ college recognised by Maharashtra Nursing Council & The Institute from which the candidate has underwent for the said nursing courses must implement the Indian Nursing Council's syllabus.
5.3	The applicant must have registered for RNRM to Maharashtra Nursing Council and should submit the certificate of registration and certificate of Diploma / Degree at the time of application.
5.4	A candidate allowed to appear for the said competitive exam does not mean that, he/she is qualified for the appointment to the post of Staff Nurse. A candidate will be declared qualified only after he/she successfully passed the said exam. and will fulfill to produce the all required original certificates during the process of scrutiny of original documents and will be declared qualified by the Competent Scrutiny of original documents and will be declared qualified by the Competent Authority.
5.5	Age: The Candidate should be not more than 33 years on 1st September 2010. Age relaxation up to 5 years for Backward Classes (38 Years) (PAP & PH Candidate should be not more than 45 years.)
6	The number of vacant post may very depending on the vacancy position at the time of recruitment. The recruitment to the post of Staff Nurse will be made as per available vacancies and as per need with taking into account the roster point.
7	DECLARATION OF RESULT AND PREPARATION OF STATE MERIT LIST
7.1	The Competent Authority shall conduct of competitive written examination for Staff Nurses recruitment, evaluate the answer sheets and prepare the State Merit List (SML)
7.2	The Competent Authority will prepare a Merit List indicating Merit List Number, Name, Category Merit Number and Marks scored by the Candidate. The same will be made available at all the Govt. Medical College & Hospitals mentioned at Annexure "A".

7.3	Corrections if any in the mark sheet e.g. Name, Age, Sex, Category, etc. representation should be submitted to the Competent Authority within 3 days from the date of declaration of merit list through the office of respective Divisional Authorities.
8	STATE MERIT LIST
8.1	The Competent Authority will prepare two separate State Merit List of eligible candidates. (1) State Merit List of eligible candidate those who have completed their General Nursing And Midwifery / Psychiatric Nursing / Orthopedic Nursing or Operation Theatre technique from the Govt. Institutions under the Director of Medical Education & Research and Directorate of Health Services, Govt. of Maharashtra. (2) Those who have completed their above nursing courses from other institutions recognised by the M.N.C. Accordingly the selection will be made with giving the first preferences to the candidates who have completed their nursing courses as per State Merit List No.1 & if the seats remained vacant then may be consider the candidates those who have completed their nursing courses from other institution according to Merit List No.-2
8.2	The Selection List will be valid up to one Year only from the date of declaration of the selection list.
8.3	To be eligible for selection to recruitment for Staff Nurse post a candidate must secure 50 % marks in competitive written examination.
8.4	Tie-Breaker-Determination of the inter-se-merit of candidates obtaining.
8.4.1	Equal Marks in MHN-CWT In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the MHN-CWT 2010 the inter-se-merit of such candidates will be determined in the order of Preferences as under.
8.4.2	The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at First, Second and Third Year of Revised General Nursing and Midwifery Course / B.Sc. Nursing taken together shall be preferred. If the tie still persists.
8.4.3	The candidate will more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 th Std.) shall be preferred. If the tie still persists.
8.4.4	The third Preference will be decided on the basis of higher total marks secured by the applicant at 10 th Std. examination, taken as a whole converted in percentage.
8.4.5	If tie still persist an older candidate will be preferred over a younger candidate.
9	CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE :
	Failure of the candidate in making full and correct statement in the application form and/or suppression of any information would lead disqualification of the candidate, even at the later date. Such a candidate will be debarred from the entire selection process.

9.1	As per Government Gazette Dated 25/05/2006 a request of Selected candidates for transfer will be considered only after completion 6 Year of service from the recruitment place.
9.3	Appointment order will be issued to the selected candidates and a probation period of two years of such candidates for the post of Staff Nurse will be started as soon as he/she will report to the place where he/she will be appointed. During this period if the candidates remained absent from the duty without legal & written permission of the head of the institute his services will be immediately terminated without giving him a prior notice, no further enquiry in this regards will be held.
9.4	The selection of the candidate for the post of Staff Nurse will be made on the basis of the certificates which he/she will produce at the time of submission of the documents (Receipts in lieu of certificate will not be entertained, certificates produced latter will not consider.) The candidates should not that it is his/her full responsibility to produce all the required documents at the time of submission (i.e. if a candidate is belong to O.B.C. he/she must have a certificate of Non Creamy Layer with him at the time of submission other wise he/she will be consider in OPEN Category). In any condition no changes will be made in the final selection list prepared & published by the Competent Authority/ Selection Committee.
9.5	A selected candidate will be given a 30 days time limit to join at the recommended institute from the date of issue of appointment order. In any condition this limit will not be extended. A candidate fails to join the said institution in stipulated period will not be consider again and his/her claim for the entire selection will be laps & he/she will be disqualified from the entire process.
9.6	The address of correspondence given by the candidate should be in detailed & correct. If any changes made in the correspondence address till the date of appoint should be informed to the Competent Authority in written by Registered Post A.D. in time, otherwise if the letter/order posted on the address given by the candidate is not reached to the candidate he/she himself will be responsible for the same.
9.7	If any candidate found to pressurized at any steps during or after the admission process or found to be adopting indiscipline manners or found to be leading an unauthorized persons to interfere in admission process will be declared disqualified and his selection will be cancelled.
9.8	The competent Authority/ Government have reserved his final rights to make any changes/modifications in the procedure specified in the Information Brochure.
9.9	The typographically mistakes in application form & Information Brochure will not lead to the candidates to take any disadvantages.

(1) Following seats are reserved for categories detailed below. Selection will be made strictly on the basis of Merit within each category only. **Constitutional reservation shall be available for candidates of Maharashtra State only.**

Candidates belonging to categories of Backward Classes stated at (A) to (H) will be required to submit the Caste Certificate/Caste Validity Certificate/Tribe Validity Certificate.

(3) NON-CREAMY LAYER

PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED (PH)

- 1) As per G.R. No.MES-1202/(81) MED-1, Dated 19/08/2005 3 % of the total available vacant posts in Government Medical Colleges & Hospitals, Health Unit etc. are reserved for the physically handicapped candidates. As per Government of Maharashtra guidelines the physically handicapped candidates have "One Leg Affected (OL-1 %) Partly deaf (PD-1 %) Partly sighted (PS-1%) disability minimum 40 % only"

However, such a candidate will be required to undergo medical examination by a special Medical Board constituted for this purpose. The Medical Board after ascertainment of his/her disability must be satisfied that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the course, despite his/her disability.

The Medical Board at Sir J. J. Group of Hospitals, Mumbai or the Special Board constituted for this purpose by Competent Authority will also work as referral board in required cases. No other disability shall be allowed as per the Government of Maharashtra guidelines.

- 2) Candidate is required to submit the proof of his disability by way of a certificate in prescribed Pro-forma from Civil Surgeon of a District Hospital/Medical Board/Medical Superintendent of Government Medical College & Hospital in Maharashtra; or from the Director of All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Haji Ali, Mumbai; (as per Prescribed Pro-forma) at the time of submission of documents.

Verification of the disability will be carried out by special Medical Board of the College/Hospital at the place of the Designated Authorities before selection for a post finalized. The concerned Regional/Designated Authorities for the areas are as under.

- 10) In case the Admit Card is not received the office of the Competent Authority should be contacted immediately for duplicate Admit Card.
