

The Shikshan Shulka Samiti decides on the following issues in its Meetings held on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2007 and on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2007 – for Higher & Technical Education and Medical Education respectively, the relevant extracts of the Minutes are appended herewith for information and necessary action.

1. Filing of an Appeal before the Samiti in a stipulated time period.
2. Last dates of filing of the Proposal for fixation of fee structure for AY 2007-08 – 31<sup>st</sup> July 2007 for Higher & Technical Education Courses & 15<sup>th</sup> August 2007 for Medical Education Courses.
3. Declaration of Interim fee for AY 2007-08.

Item No.6: To fix the time for filing revision/ review and for charging penalty, if there is any delay in filing it.

The Office Secretary informed the Samiti that many Colleges/ Institutes/ students approach the Samiti for revision in the fee structure or making the appeal for reconsideration of the fee fixed by the Samiti. The Office Secretary further informed that presently there is no any period or time stipulated by the Samiti. In view of this, the Samiti decides that any party would like to file an appeal / review application for revision / review, should approach the Samiti within a period of 30 days immediately after declaring the fee structure on web-site for the respective academic year. The Samiti further decides that if any party files any review application/ appeal / revision after 30 days of declaration of the decision of the Samiti on web-site, the Samiti would charge penalty of Rs.25,000/- for each course, if any, for condoning the delay. Delay only to the extent of 30 days can be condoned.

Item No.7: To decide the cut off date for submission of the proposals for fixation of fee structure for the academic year 2007-08.

Item No.8: Any other item with the permission of the Chair.

- (a) To fix the time for filing revision/ review and for charging penalty, if there is any delay in filing it.

The Office Secretary informed the Samiti that many Colleges/ Institutes/ students approach the Samiti for revision in the fee structure or making the appeal for reconsideration of the fee fixed by the Samiti. The Office Secretary further informed that presently there is no any period or time stipulated by the Samiti. Accordingly, Colleges / Institutes have now started submitting their proposals to the Samiti office. It is necessary to declare the cut-off date for acceptance of the said proposals. The Samiti for the present decides to set 15<sup>th</sup> August 2007 – as a cut-off date for submission of the proposals from the Colleges/ Institutes of Health Science Courses for fixation of fee structure for academic year 2007-08.

- (c) Declaration of interim fee for the academic year 2007-08:

The Samiti considered the issue of deciding the interim fee for the academic year 2007-08, since the admissions process for the new academic year 2007-08 is going to start very soon. It was decided that the interim fee for the academic year 2007-08 would be given only to those Colleges/ institutes who have approached the Samiti and finalized the fee structure for the academic year 2006-07. No interim fee for the academic year 2007-08 will be declared for Colleges/ Institutes, whose fee for academic year 2006-07 is not finalized by the Samiti. The interim fee would be 7.5% more than what was finalised for the year 2006-07. But in case the process of finalisation is going on for the academic year 2006-07, then the College/Institute would charge the same fee as charged as interim for the academic year 2006-07. After finalisation their interim fee to be declared for academic year 2007-08.
