**NOTIFICATION**

**MHT-CET 2009 - ADMISSION PROCESS**

**(Admission to Homoeopathy course-Preference form filling for the candidates who have not filled preference form)**

This Notification is being issued in regard to the process of selection and admissions to be granted to the **1<sup>st</sup> year of undergraduate Health Science Courses for the Academic Year 2009-2010**, pursuant to the Common Entrance Test (MHT-CET 2009) conducted by Govt. of Maharashtra on 12.05.2009. The counseling and preference form filling process will be carried out for the admission to Homoeopathy Course for second round only, as per the following schedule.

Candidates can obtain the Information Brochure free of cost after showing the original MHT-CET-2009 marksheet, from the Regional Centre for their respective districts from 13<sup>th</sup> August 2009. A copy of the Preference Form Information Brochure is also made available on website of the Directorate of Medical Education and Research (DMER), i.e. [www.dmer.org](http://www.dmer.org).

**Candidates who have filled preference form previously during 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2009 to 11<sup>th</sup> July 2009 are not eligible for this preference round. Eligible candidates can fill preferences of Homoeopathy courses only (Except candidates of Marathwada region from NT2 constitutional reservation category with Hilly area specified reservation claim).**

On the scheduled dates and at the scheduled sessions, the candidates in accordance with their State Merit List (SML) Numbers are required to attend in person, the counseling at the respective Regional centers as set out in Table 1 below.

Candidates from SML No. 1 to 37897 belonging to **Marathwada region from NT2 constitutional reservation category with Hilly area specified reservation claim only**, who have not filled the preference form previously, are called to fill the preference form for MBBS and BHMS course. All such eligible candidates can fill the preference on any of the day between 18th to 20th August 2009 between 9.00 am to 5.00pm at the respective regional center as set out in Table No. 1.

The candidate must report to the respective Regional Centre personally (proxy will not be permitted), as set out in Table no.1 at the specified time and date set out in Table no.2 above, alongwith all the relevant documents in terms of the Information Brochure. It is made hereby clear that only constitutional reservation claim will be considered, and specified reservation claim will not be considered, since there are no specified reservation seats for Homoeopathy course. If the relevant documents are not produced by the candidates at the time of counseling, claim will not be granted.

As per schedule, selection list of all the courses for second round will be declared on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2009, based on the preferences filled by the candidates.
