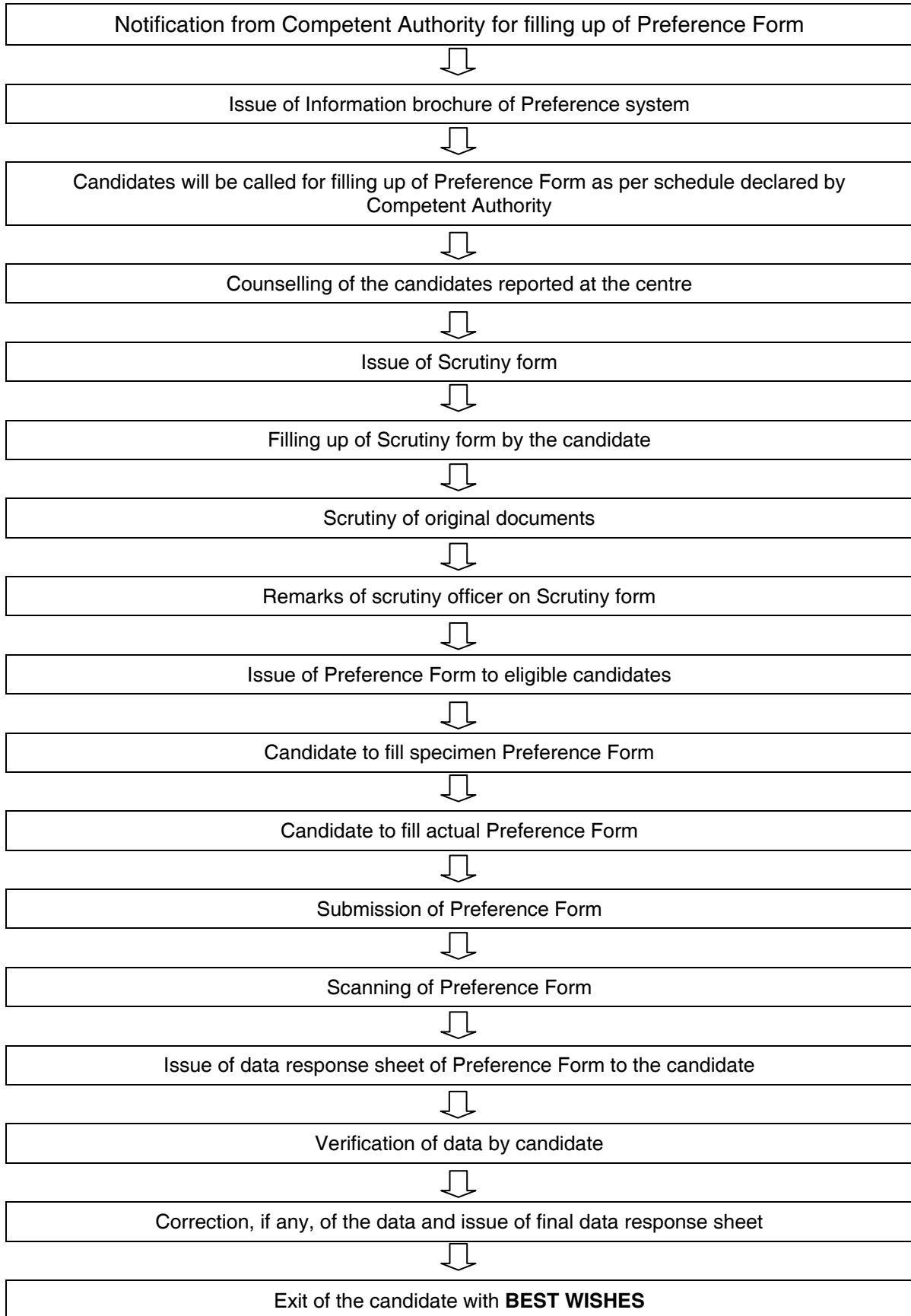

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# Counselling and Preference form filling Procedure

## Information and Instructions for Candidates

1. Admissions to Medical Superspeciality (DM/MCh) courses for academic year 2008 will be done by counselling & Preference form filling system.
2. Specified number of candidates from MH-SSET-2008 State Merit List are called as per following schedule for preference form filling and counselling.

3. **Certificates / Documents :**

- i) At the centre the candidates must bring all relevant certificates/documents listed below in original and one set of attested photocopies of the same for scrutiny.
- ii) Candidate should bring black ballpoint pens, clipboard (Writing Pad), HB pencil and eraser.
  - a) MH-SSET-2008 Marksheet.
  - b) Nationality certificate / valid passport.
  - c) SSC Passing Certificate / valid passport.
  - d) First, Second and Third MBBS Marksheets (Final part-I & Part-II wherever applicable)
  - e) Attempt certificate of all MBBS examinations and MD/MS examinations from the head of the institution.
  - f) MBBS degree certificate.
  - g) MD/MS Passing certificate issued by University or College or certificate of passing examination / Degree Certificate.
  - h) Permanent Registration certificate of Maharashtra Medical Council or other state Medical Councils in India / MCI.
  - i) Certificate from Head of Institute showing that the Medical College/ Institute from which the candidate has passed MD/MS examination is recognised by Medical Council of India.
  - j) Medical Fitness Certificate from a RMP.

**Note:** In case of dispute during counselling the following documents will be verified. Therefore candidates should also bring these documents at the time of counselling.

- i) Attested photo copy of the Computer Application Form.
- ii) Receipt-cum-identity-card.

4. **Orientation :** Candidates will assemble at the venue as per the programme. They will be given orientation about the process. Counseling for Preference form filling will be done. The Candidate must be present in person. Proxy will not be allowed.

5. **Preference Form information brochure :** This Preference form & information brochure is made available to candidates at Grant Medical College, Byculla, Mumbai. It contains relevant information about the process, distribution of seats, status Recognition of MMC / status of Recognition / Not-Recognition of MCI, subject & college codes, and **specimen copy of Preference form** for practice. Candidates should read the information brochure of Preference system carefully. It is also made available on DMER's website [www.dmer.org](http://www.dmer.org).

6. **Scrutiny Form :** Scrutiny form will be issued to the candidates. Candidates should fill in required information. They should arrange documents in order as per list given on scrutiny form in one set of originals and another set of attested Xerox copies.
7. **Verification of Documents :** Candidates will be called by State Merit List numbers. They should submit scrutiny form with a set of attested Xerox copies and show the originals. The documents will be verified by scrutiny officer & eligibility will be endorsed on the scrutiny form. Candidates should not submit original documents, but take back the originals with them after scrutiny.
8. **Fees :-**  
The tuition fees for Government and Municipal Corporation Medical Colleges and Bombay Hospital and TATA Memorial Hospital, Mumbai is Rs.18,000/- per year and admission fees Rs.1,000/- Gymkhana fees Rs.500/-. (subject to revision by the Govt./appropriate authorities)
9. **Subject & College codes :-**  
The subject & college code is a **two digit number specific for each subject & college combination.**
10. Subject & College code numbers are specific. Code No. represents a particular subject in specific college. e.g. :-

11. Subject & College codes are given to courses existing in those colleges. For these codes one or more number of seats may be available. Therefore subject and college code choices can be given as preferences, considering eventuality of availability of such seats. Seat distribution is shown in separate table.
12. **Seats distribution chart** contains available seats. Seat distribution chart is subject to change as per instructions of MCI/Court directives/Transfer of PG Teacher.
13. **Preference form :** Candidates will collect the Preference form from the counter. The Preference form will be pre printed along with the relevant information of the candidate, which he/she has filled in his/her original application form along with his Roll Number, State Merit List Number, MH-SSET Marks etc. Preference form should be handled carefully and should not be folded, stapled or spoilt in any way.
14. **Candidate will be issued only one Preference Form. Duplicate/another Preference form will not be issued.**
15. In case the candidate is not eligible for admission according to rules, the Preference form will not be issued or cancelled if already issued.
16. Candidates remaining absent for the process of preference from filling will not be issued preference form after the programme is over.
17. Candidate should read all instructions before filling the preference form. Candidate should note carefully the subject & college codes. Candidate must first fill the specimen copy of Preference form given in the brochure with pencil for practice. Once the candidate is satisfied with his choices filled on specimen copy of Preference form, then he should start filling the actual Preference form using **black ball point pen.**
18. The Candidates are advised to clearly note the following contents carefully.  
Any Candidate if selected on merit for Superspeciality courses not recognised by the Medical Council of India (MCI) will be admitted only on the submission of an

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undertaking that he / she is fully aware of the Non-recognised status of the course and its consequences.

19. Candidate should write his most preferred subject and college code as Preference no. 1 followed by his next choice as Preference no.2 and so on. While filling the subject and college codes, number should be written in boxes, one digit in each box (2 digit number - 2 boxes). **As the form will be scanned by Computer, candidate should write the codes with black ball point pen and with neat, legible, clear handwriting.**
20. Candidate must be very careful while filling the Preference form. Candidate can fill desired number of preferences for which he/she is eligible. The same subject and college code should not be filled more than once. In case the candidate fills same code more than once, its higher Preference number will be considered and subsequent repeated preference number will be ignored. If the candidate fills wrong code number it will not be considered.
21. If a candidate does not give preference for a particular subject and college codes, then it means that he is not interested/does not want to take those subject and college combinations. Candidate should note that there will be no change/addition/deletion in his list of preferences at later date/stage.
22. If a candidate has given preferences and if he by his merit and preference gets selected for a particular subject and college code; then he has to join that course as per procedure. In case he does not join the course, he is debarred from subsequent admission process of MH-SSET-2008.
23. In case candidate is not selected for any of his preferences in first round, then he remains eligible for vacant seats round for these preferences only, which he has given in the preference form.
24. For filling of vacant seats after first round, same preference form will be considered and no separate preference form will be required to be filled by the candidate.
25. The candidate should submit his duly filled Preference form at the specified counter. Candidate shall inform regarding any correction in the name if required at the counter.
26. **Data Response Sheet & Verification** :- The Preference form will be scanned and data response sheet in duplicate will be generated and will be given to the candidate for checking. Candidate should check that the data i.e. SML No. Name and his Preferences and subject college codes have been correctly printed. After verification the candidate can report discrepancy if any in the data and it will be duly corrected according to his/her preference form. If the candidate does not report any discrepancy, it will be presumed that the data entered against his/her name is correct and subsequently corrections will not be made at later time/date.

The candidate should sign the data response sheet copies. Candidate will be given one copy of data response sheet for his record and office will keep the preference form and one copy of data response sheet.
27. Candidate should note that the **Preferences** of subject and college combination codes, once entered in the record/data, after verification by the candidate, shall be **final and irrevocable**. Thereafter there can not be any change, addition or deletion of Preference entered by candidate. This final data shall be used in entire selection process for the admission to Medical Superspeciality courses.
28. This completes the process of Preference form filling.

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## **SUBSEQUENT PROCESS**

1. The collected data will be centrally processed for the selection of candidates for DM/MCh courses.
2. **The selection will be done as per merit (SML no.) and on the basis of Preferences given by candidates in Preference form.**
3. The list of candidates selected for DM/MCh courses shall be displayed at the website of DMER i.e. [www.dmer.org](http://www.dmer.org).
4. The selection list will be declared by 25<sup>th</sup> July 2008. It will be displayed on the website. List of selected candidates will be sent to all concerned colleges. Candidate should report and pay the fees and submit original certificates at respective colleges by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2008. No separate selection letter will be issued to candidates.
5. If the candidate does not report by specified date, then his / her selection automatically stands cancelled and he / she will be debarred from the subsequent process.
6. All the institutions should inform the joining of the candidates and vacancies arising due to non-joining of the candidates and cancellations at their institutions after the last date of reporting, immediately to DMER office.
7. The academic term of Medical Superspeciality courses will start from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2008.
8. **Process for filling vacant seats:** After first round, the vacant seats, if any will be filled in. For these seats the selected as well as not selected candidates who have filled the Preference form are eligible. For these process MH-SSET-2008 merit list of eligible candidates will be operated from SML number 1 onwards. The candidate getting selected in round one will be considered for betterment in the subsequent selection process. The betterment herein means the higher Preference exercised by the candidate. **The shift in such betterment shall be compulsory and mandatory.** Such candidates will have to collect original certificates and admissible refund of fees as per procedure from previous college and join the new course and college within stipulated joining period.
9. **Status Retention of Admission :**

After selection in first/subsequent process, if the candidate desires to retain the same selection (subject & college) and does not want to take any further betterment, then he can do so by filling 'Status Retention Form' in the prescribed proforma given on page no. 17 of MH-SSET-2008 brochure, within specified time period after selection which will be notified alongwith selection list. 'Status Retention Form' to be submitted to the Competent Authority through the college where he is admitted. However candidate should note that his name will be deleted from the further selection process for the academic year 2008.
10. The following candidates will not be held eligible for subsequent admission process.
  - i) **Selected in the first round but not reporting to the college and / or not paying the fees.**
  - ii) **Other conditions under rule 9.4 of MH-SSET-2008 brochure.**
11. In case some seats remain vacant due to non claimancy by any candidate from specified number of candidates called for preference form filling, then such seats will be notified on website and required additional number of candidates will be called by SML Numbers for preference form filling, as required for allotment of such seats. In this process the candidates who have filled in the preference form previously will not be called again for filling the preference form.
12. Candidate who has confirmed his/her admission may cancel it by submitting an application to the concerned Dean. Deans should inform such cancellations to DMER immediately.

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13. Candidates may resign before 12<sup>th</sup> September 2008, to be eligible for next MH-SSET-2007.
  14. Candidates canceling his/her admission after 12/9/2008 will not be eligible for subsequent two years for MH-SSET.
  15. The procedure for refund of fees shall be as under.
    - a) On or before 12/9/2008 : Rs.1000/- from the tuition fee.
    - b) After 12/9/2008 : No refund
  16. Last date of admission process for filling vacant seats for Medical Superspeciality courses is 30<sup>th</sup> September 2008.
  17. Candidate should read MH-SSET-2008 brochure for other relevant information.
