## NOTICE

### **Personal Counseling Process of NEET MDS 2017 for Admissions to Dental Postgraduate Courses (MDS) in State of Maharashtra (Revised)**

This revised notice is in continuation with the notice No. State CET Cell/NEET 2017/Personal Counseling/Notification No.16/361/2017, Dated 13/05/2017 regarding admission to MDS course issued by this office. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt of India vide an order No. V.12025/181/2016-DE Dated 11th May 2017 lowered the qualifying percentile of NEET MDS 2017 by 7.5 percentile for the academic session 2017-18 only.

In view of this order issued by Government of India, the notice. No. State CET Cell/NEET 2017/Personal Counseling/Notification No.16/361/2017, for admission to MDS course in Maharashtra State issued by this office is revised. The schedule for this round from Table III is as per the following,

All the eligible candidates should download their fresh revised score card from website of National Board of Examinations ([www. http://nbe.edu.in/neetmds/](http://nbe.edu.in/neetmds/)). Candidates should appear for the counseling according to the revised NEET MDS All India rank. All the candidates from open category who have secured 50 percentile and above marks for such candidates, eligibility as per the notice dated 13th May 2017 is applicable. All the candidates from Reserved category who have secured 40 percentile and above marks, for such candidates eligibility as per the notice dated 13th May 2017 is applicable.

For the candidates, which have been made eligible as per the order of Government of India, i.e. for open category candidates with qualifying percentile upto 42.5 and for reserved category candidates with qualifying percentile upto 32.5 the eligibility criteria will be as follows,

Candidates should be eligible as per the revised score card of NEET MDS 2017 issued by The National Board of Examinations. As far as other eligibility criteria for admission to MDS course in the State of Maharashtra through The Competent Authority, State CET Cell, Government of Maharashtra, candidates should be eligible as per NEET MDS 2017 brochure published by this office.

### **Instruction to the Candidates**

1. For all these candidates, the other conditions of eligibility i.e. Caste certificate/ Caste validity/ Non creamy Layer certificate/ Bond conditions etc. will be applicable.
2. The selection process will be according to the rules of MDS 2017 as stated in the respective information brochure. All the desirous candidates who are eligible as per the rules should attend the personal counseling round according to the above schedule. **Proxy will not be permitted.**
3. The candidates should bring **all the original documents** for verification as per the rule no. 11.3 of NEET MDS 2017 Information brochure.
4. Candidates who have already joined a PG Course through Competent Authority, State CET CELL, Maharashtra and not submitted status retention form should bring

a certificate issued by Dean/Principal of the institute where he/she has joined, stating that the original certificates have been retained by them. The said certificate should include the list of original documents.

5. Candidates should note that they have to confirm the admission immediately after allotment of a seat by paying Rs.1500/- in cash as admission fee and deposit all the original documents at the time of personal counseling, along with paying one year tuition and other fees by cheque. The submission of original documents and payment of fees will be at the respective counter of the Institution at the site of counseling.
6. The amount of tuition fee of respective college and subject is available on the website. A candidate not paying the one year tuition fee and other fee by cheque on the Spot will not be considered as admitted.
7. All the candidates should note that they should not attend above rounds as per their state merit list Number (SML). They must attend round as per their Revised **All India Rank Number**.
8. Inclusion of the name in the revised provisional merit list does not mean that the candidate is eligible for this round. Eligibility will be verified during the round by original document verification.
9. No extra time will be given for paying tuition & other fees and for deposition of original documents. Candidate asking for extra time will be held ineligible for opting a seat.
10. All the candidates submitting status retention form will not be allowed to enter in the premises of the admission process.
11. All the candidates opting a seat during this round have no option of resigning or non joining. If they do so, then penalty mentioned in the brochure will be applicable.
