IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION FOR ONLINE PREFERENCE (CHOICE) FILLING PROCESS

In continuation to Notice dated 23.03.2018 the preference form filling process is scheduled from 31/03/2018 to 03/04/2018. The concerned candidates should note the following important instructions/guidelines.

- 1) Document Verification Process for General / Institution and NRI candidates to Post Graduate Medical/ Dental Courses in the State of Maharashtra is schedule from 26/03/2018 to 01/04/2018.
- 2) The provisional State Merit list (SML) of Eligible Candidates will be published on 31/03/2018 (for General / In-Service Quota Candidates) and for NRI quota candidates it will be published on 02/04/2018. The provisional state merit list of NEET MDS 2018 In-service quota will be published on 31/03/2018 and the said will be subject to the outcome of Write Petition Number 1795/2018 filed at Hon'ble Bombay High Court Bench at Nagpur.
- 3) The online preference form filling process for General / In-service Candidate is schedule from 31/03/2018 to 03/04/2018 and for NRI Candidate form 02/04/2018 to 03/04/2018.
- 4) All the available Postgraduate seats in the private colleges are divided in to following three groups.
 - a- 50% Seats for State Quota with 'X' fee
 - b- 35% Seats for Institutional Quota with 3 × fee (maxim)
 - c- 15% Seats for NRI Quota with 5 × fee (Maximum)('X' = fee decided by FRA for State quota seats)
- 5) All the previously Published College and subject combination codes of Government / Private /Unaided Minority College Courses will remain the same, however they will be with following suffix.

S/I/N

Suffix **S** = State Quota (50% each in government / Private Colleges/Minority Colleges)

Suffix **I** = Institutional (Management) Quota in Private / Minority Colleges.

Suffix **N** = NRI Quota in Private / Minority Colleges only

In Government / Corporation Colleges all seats will be under CET State Quota and will have suffix 'S'. In Private unaided / Minority Medical Colleges each preference code will have Suffix 'S'/'I'/'N'.

For a given College and Subject combination the previously published four digit code will remain the same but the suffix will have to be added depending on the preference (choice). Candidate will fill separate codes for same college same subject combination. For e.g. as under-

0101S	For Grant Government Medical College, Mumbai- Medicine (M.D); State Quota
2701S	For MIMER Talegoan Pune - Medicine (M.D); State Quota
2701I	For MIMER Talegoan Pune - Medicine (M.D); Institutional Quota
2701N	For MIMER Talegoan Pune - Medicine (M.D); NRI Quota
3306I	For NKP Salve, Nagpur - Surgery (M.S); Institutional Quota
2606N	For Smt. Kashibai Navale Medical College, Pune - Surgery (M.S); NRI Quota

- 6) The candidate should verify the fee structure to State/Institutional/NRI quota seats before filling online preference. The fee structure of private unaided/Minority College is available on the website- www.sspnsamiti.gov.in
- 7) The allotment of the seat is based on the preferences submitted by the candidate for the same college and same subject with the different suffix like 'S'/'I'/'N'.
- 8) It is recommended that candidates who wish to give preference in same subject in the same college should give preferences considering fee structure in the sequence of first 'S' quota then 'I' quota and finally 'N' quota as per his/her order of preference.
- 9) In second round if a seat number is increased in the existing seat in the same subject & in the same institute then fresh preferences will not be called. While submitting the choices students should note this point.
- 10) The provisional seats Distribution in State quota was published on 08/02/2018. Now there are changes in the published seat matrix in some colleges as informed by concerned college. Candidate should take Note of the following changes in seat position (matrix) before filling online preference form.
