NEET - PG 2018 - IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR REVISED FIRST ROUND OF JOINING IN GOVT./CORP/GOVT. AIDED/PRIVATE MEDICAL COLLEGES.

This office has declared the first round of counseling process and the selection list was published on 05.04.2018. Some of the private Medical colleges have not participated in the first round. As per above references Fee structure of Institutional Quota Seats, in Private Medical Colleges has been revised and the concerned colleges are going to admit the students selected during revised First round. In view of this development, the Revised First selection list is being published on 26th April 2018.

Note:-

1. Selected Candidates should report to the College with all original documents and Pay the Fees/Deposits from 27/04/2018 to 29/04/2018 upto 5pm.
2. Candidates will have to pay revised Fee as published on DMER website/ respective college website.

3. Last date to fill the Status Retention Form is 29/04/2018 upto 5pm.
4. Candidate who have already joined and filled the status Retention form need not fill the status Retention form again.
5. Commencement of Academic Session from 02/05/2018.
6. Admitting Institute will verify the documents and ascertain eligibility of the candidates as per the NEET (PG) - 2018 brochure.
7. Candidate who have already joined and not filled status Retention form will be eligible for Second Round.
8. Selected Candidates who can not join the allotted Course at allotted college due to increased Fee Structure of 35% Institutional Quota seats will only be considered for betterment during Round II even though they are not Joined during Revised First Round Joining period. Candidate who have already joined under 35% Institutional Quota seats and willing to opt out of private college due to revised fee structure can cancel the admission at respective college. Such candidates will be made eligible for Second Round.
9. All Participating colleges are directed to keep the admission counters open on Saturday/ Sunday/ Holiday (all reporting days including) for facilitating students admission.
10. NEET PG 2018 State Quota Second and subsequent MoP UP round will be scheduled in due course after Surrender of All India Quota seats to State Quota.
