Personal Counseling Process of NEET PG/MDS 2017 for Admissions to Medical/Dental Postgraduate Courses (MD/MS/Diploma/MDS) in State of Maharashtra

In compliance to the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India order in IA No. 7 & 8 in writ Petition(s) (civil) No 76/2015 and WP 314 & 328 of 2015 dated 18th January, 2016, there was 2nd round of allotment process from 23rd April, 2017 to 09th May 2017, under 50% All India Quota 2017. The vacant All India Quota post graduate Medical/Dental seats in Government/Corporation Medical Colleges, have been surrendered to state of Maharashtra on 09th May, 2017 (After 5.00 p.m.).

This office has completed the first round of counseling process and the selection list was published on 05.05.2017. At the end of the above stated rounds there are vacant seats. Some of the private colleges were not included in the first round, now their seats have been added during this round. The schedule to fill vacant seats of Govt./Corp Colleges and Pvt. unaided/Deemed University (50% State Quota, 35 % Institutional Quota and 15 % NRI quota) by Personal Counseling round will be as stated below.

Instruction to the Candidates

- For all these candidates, the other conditions of eligibility i.e. Caste certificate/
 Caste validity/ Non creamy Layer certificate/ Bond conditions etc. will be applicable.
- 2. The selection process will be according to the rules of NEET PG/MDS 2017 as stated in the respective information brochure. All the desirous candidates who are eligible as per the rules should attend the personal counseling round according to the above schedule. Proxy will not be permitted.
- 3. The candidates should bring <u>all the original documents</u> for verification as per the rule no. 11.3 of NEET PG 2017/NEET MDS 2017 Information brochure.
- 4. Candidates who have already joined a PG Course through Competent Authority, State CET CELL, Maharashtra and not submitted status retention form should bring a certificate issued by Dean/Principal of the institute where

he/she has joined, stating that the original certificates have been retained by them. The said certificate should include the list of original documents.

5. Candidates should note that they have to confirm the admission immediately after allotment of a seat by paying Rs.1500/- in cash as admission fee and deposit all the original documents at the time of personal counseling, along with paying one year tuition and other fees by cheque. The submission of original documents and payment of fees will be at the respective counter of the Institution at the site of counseling.

6. The amount of tuition fee of respective college and subject is available on the website. A candidate not paying the one year tuition fee and other fee by cheque on the Spot will not be considered as admitted.

7. All the candidates should note that they should not attend above rounds as per their state merit list Number (SML). They must attend round as per their All India Rank Number.

8. Inclusion of the name in the revised provisional merit list does not mean that the candidate is eligible for this round. Eligibility will be verified during the round by original document verification.

9. No extra time will be given for paying tuition & other fees and for deposition of original documents. Candidate asking for extra time will be held ineligible for opting a seat.

10. All the candidates submitting status retention form will not be allowed to enter in the premises of the admission process.

11. All the candidates opting a seat during this round have no option of resigning or non joining. If they do so, then penalty mentioned in the brochure will be applicable.
