## NOTIFICATION

### Provisional Result/Marks of PGD-CET-2016

The Common Entrance Test for Postgraduate Dental Courses, PGD-CET-2016 was conducted on Sunday, 24<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 by the Competent Authority and Commissioner, CET CELL, Government of Maharashtra as per Act, 2015. The provisional result/marks of the same is being declared on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2016, after 6.00 pm.

In view of objections/representations received from the candidates, the Competent Authority has taken opinion from concerned subject experts. The subject experts have opined that One (01) question in the question paper of the aforesaid examination is defective. The Competent Authority, on the basis of the opinion and advice of the respective subject expert has taken a decision to make this One (01) question "non-evaluative / invalid". This question carried one mark each for a correct answer. Therefore instead of reducing the maximum number of marks from 100 to 99, the Competent Authority has decided to allot one mark for this defective MCQ to all candidates who appeared in this examination, thus keeping maximum marks as 100 unchanged. The details of "Non-evaluative/ Invalid" MCQ are shown in the **Table No. - 1** at respective Sr. No. in each version.

It is further clarified that the aforesaid One (01) question have been made non-evaluative and hence if the candidate opts for verification, the answer to this question will appear as \* in the printout of the key response given to the candidate.


The subject expert also opined that there are two correct answers in One (01) question. This One (01) question having two correct options is correct and hence this is evaluative. The evaluation of this One (01) question will be done as per the two correct answers suggested by subject experts. One mark for this One (01) question will be granted to those candidates who have marked either of one correct answer key. The details of Sr. No. of question with two correct answer key is shown in **Table No. – 2**.
